Transformer is proud to work with Liverpool, UK based artist Rebecca Key in the presentation of her first US solo exhibition. Applying the set-dressing techniques she uses in her professional work within film and television, Rebecca will return Transformer to its former state - an alleyway between two housing blocks that was given a roof and storefront to create the micro-gallery space that exists today. Questioning implications of social space and gentrification, Rebecca will paint and distress Transformer's interior surfaces and introduce outside objects in a direct inversion of the space's evolution.
