Transformer presents, *bay sick: an excursion of perversion*, an exhibition of new works by Baltimore, MD based artist Felipe Pereira Gonçalves. Within this exhibition, Gonçalves will be exploring the discomfort, and joy, of coming-of-age. Using different mediums, techniques, and humor, he creates an interactive environment designed to induce nostalgia and self reflection.

Like the light from a deep-sea anglerfish, Gonçalves's work entices viewers to enter a world that is normally obscured by reason and fear. Death, childhood, and glitter are nostalgic devices meant to leave one giggling in the face of terror. Graduating from the Maryland Institute College of Art with a Bachelor of Fine Arts in 2004, Felipe Pereira Gonçalves has exhibited in San Francisco, Berkley, and around the greater Baltimore/DC region.
